1. A police officer's job **is dangerous**.
2. A doctor's job **is stressful**.
3. An accountant's job **is difficult**.
4. A gardener's job **is relaxing**.
5. An athlete's job **is exciting**.
6. A teacher's job **is boring**.

##### Adjectives + noun

- A police officer has **a dangerous job**.
- A doctor has **a stressful job**.
- An accountant has **a difficult job**.
- A gardener has **a relaxing job**.
- An athlete has **an exciting job**.
- A teacher has **a boring job**.
